

BNG Camps COVID-19 Guidelines:

1. Student Arrival Morning Temperature Check:

Camp starts at **9:00 AM.** The BNG will be open to receive students from 8:45.

Upon arrival, all students and staff are required to wear face masks. Each student and staff member will have their temperature checked using a touchless thermometer. Students arriving by car will be checked prior to exiting the car in case of illness.

Walk-in students and those arriving from public transportation will be temperature checked upon arrival. If they have a temperature greater than 100.4°F (38°C), a BNG staff member will wait with them on the City Hall front porch socially distanced whilst their parent/guardian is contacted and until their parent/guardian arrives.

2. Good To Go:

Having passed the temperature check, students must proceed into City Hall and wear their mask until they have arrived inside the Bermuda National Gallery. All students and staff will sanitise their hands with the provided sanitiser. Students may then remove their masks and follow the government mandated social distancing guidelines within the space.

3. Daily Camp Guidelines:

Students will socially distance at all times during daily camp activities. Each student's workspace will be clearly marked out. Each student will be assigned their own equipment. Sharing equipment is not permitted.

Sharing food and water bottles is not permitted.

4. Moving About:

When a student leaves the BNG, whether it is for a field trip, recess break, or to use the bathroom, they must wear their mask and sanitise their hands upon return, as well as both before and after eating. Bottles of hand sanitiser will be provided for any field trips, as well as for outdoor recess and lunch.

5. Student Pick-up/Departure:

BNG summer camp ends at **3:00 PM**. Students will be released according to the permission granted by parents in the registration form. BNG will not release a student to someone not listed on the form. If there is an issue, the parent or guardian will be contacted immediately for confirmation.

Parents should not enter the BNG, students will be brought out to them for collection.

6. Antigen Testing

All students and staff are required to submit proof of a negative antigen test the Sunday before camp starts. Students who do not provide this will not be allowed to attend camp.

Sick Policy:

Any child or member of staff with a fever equal to or greater than 100.4°F (38°C) must stay home. Staff/children with any COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, muscle aches, fatigue, difficulty breathing, sore throat, headache, diarrhoea, vomiting, or sudden loss of smell and taste) should stay home from symptom onset and seek medical attention immediately. When in doubt, parents should consult their child's doctor for guidance.

Parents are **required** to report if student absences are due to any COVID-related symptoms.

Isolation Room: If a child or teacher develops COVID symptoms while at camp, they will be monitored in an isolation room while their parent or guardian is called to immediately collect them.

Covid Case: If we become aware of a suspected COVID-19 case at camp, or of a case associated with a close contact of someone who has attended camp, camp will be closed for professional deep cleaning. The programme will resume only after approval from the Bermuda Government Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.

Cleaning & Sanitising Schedule – Twice daily, at lunchtime and end of day, a staff member is required to wipe down all “hotspot” areas with approved cleaning supplies. At the end of each week, all equipment and materials will be wiped down. Additional deep cleaning will be commissioned by an external service provider as required.

Only approved cleaning supplies are to be used for scheduled cleaning.
